A common question I have heard is: Can we give to One Great Day online? The answer is "yes". Simply go to the ClearView website (<http://clearview.org>) and click on the word "Giving" at the top of the page. Then click on the "Make a one-time donation" button at the top right of that screen. Fill in the information. You will be given an option on the final screen as to where to designate the gift. Simply state you wish the gift to go to One Great Day Offering.

On September 16, we will also have special offering envelopes available to give to the One Great Day offering. These will be in the chairs as you enter the Worship Center or Chapel. Simply use this envelope to give your One Great Day offering.

Leigh Ann and I are online givers for our regular giving. On September 16th, we will be giving our One Great Day at the church. We will give through the special envelopes provided. It's just a personal thing that we want to bring a physical, tangible gift for this special time of giving. But please know, if you wish to give online or give early and designate to One Great Day, that will be good as well.

Finally, we set a goal of being able to give an amount equal to or greater than a week's income for each household. For some of you, this may have been a difficult year financially. Maybe you can't do as much as one week. Maybe you can only do a little. Please don't feel any less a part of this day. We will be celebrating all God is doing through ClearView. We are all a part of that!

Don't forget to plan to come back Sunday night, September 16. We will be announcing the amount of the offering, but there will be much more as we observe the Lord's Supper together. We will have the choir and orchestra leading in worship. We will hear testimonies of lives changed by God's grace.
