All Severe Abuse Allegations	All severe abuse investigative activities will be completed by the case worker assigned to the case and/or CPIT team members.
	a) Required:
	◆ Convene CPIT
	◆ Review DCS History
	 ◆ Contact referent and send referent notification letter
	 Interview/observe child victim(s)
	 Photograph (as appropriate) of the child, injuries, and/or environment
	 Photograph any objects/items used to cause the injury or condition
	◆ Interview and assess risk to other children in the home
	♦ Visit home visit or location of incident
	 Interview parent/caregiver or obtain interview from law enforcement
	◆ Interview other adults living in the home
	♦ Obtain medical exam and/or treatment for the alleged victim

	Obtain medical exam and/or treatment for the alleged victim if child is non-verbal or disclosure
	Obtain medical records (previous and current)
	♦ Interview perpetrator or obtain interview from law enforcement
	♦ Interview witnesses, collaterals, other professionals or agencies
	◆ Complete background checks
	◆ Complete Structured Decision Making (SDM) or other assessments as appropriate
	b) Recommended:
	Psychological evaluation, to include psychosexual component
	◆ Consult with Well-Being Unit
	◆ Conduct other records check (educational, mental health, community/social services agency)
Child Death-Near Death:	a) Required:
	♦ Follow DCS Policy 20.27 Child Death-Near Death Rapid Response
	◆ Enter Date of Death within one (1) hour of case assignment
	◆ Convene CPIT
	♦ Review DCS History, link and establish case within 5 business days of case assignment
	Contact referent and send referent notification letter
	Observe near child victim
	 Interview other children in the home, observe all non-verbal children in the home (e.g., infants) within thirty (30) days of case assignment.
	◆ Complete initial SDM Assessment on surviving children (and victim if near death)
	◆ Enter all case dictation within five (5) business days of when contacts occurred.

	Assess risk to other children in the home
	 Obtain a medical exam of other children in the home if the death is suspected to be a result of abuse or neglect
	 Visit home and location of incident
	Photograph location of incident
	 Interview parent/caregiver or obtain interview from law enforcement
	Interview other adults living in the home
	 Obtain medical exam and/or treatment for the alleged victim (if near death)
	Obtain medical records (previous and current) of alleged child victim
	 Obtain autopsy from DCS Safety Nurse who will request an autopsy report from the Medical Examiner when available
	 Interview perpetrator or obtain interview from law enforcement
	 Interview witnesses, collaterals, other professionals or agencies
	Complete background checks
	 Complete Structured Decision Making (SDM) or other assessments as appropriate (initially at closure, unless otherwise stated)
	Note: It is not required for the DCS case manager to observe the deceased child

	• Refer for psychological evaluation of children or parents/caretakers (see note attached) as applicable
	Arrange counseling services for family
	◆ Consult with Well-Being Unit

	Take photographs of near fatality child victim, as appropriate
	◆ Conduct other records checks (educational, mental health, community/social services agency).
All Non- Severe Abuse	All activities will be completed by the case worker assigned to the case.

Physical Abuse:	Contact referent and send referent notification letter
	 Interview/observe child victim(s)
	◆ Take photographs of the injuries and any objects used to cause the injury
	 Interview and assess risk to other children in the home
	♦ Home visit or visit to location of incident
	 Interview parent/caregiver or obtain interview from law enforcement
	◆ Interview other adults living in the home
	 Interview perpetrator or obtain interview from law enforcement
	 Interview witnesses, collaterals, other professionals or agencies
	◆ Complete background check
	 Complete Structured Decision Making (SDM) and other assessments as appropriate

Drug Exposed Infant/Child:	a) Required:
	◆ Review DCS History
	Contact referent and send referent notification letter
	Interview/observe child victim(s)
	◆ Interview and assess risk to other children in the home
	 Visit home or visit location of incident (unless there is good cause to believe that the home contains facilities for the manufacturing of methamphetamines)
	 Photograph location of incident and any materials used to cause the risk/harm
	 Interview parent/caregiver or obtain interview from law enforcement
	◆ Conduct drug testing, as needed, of parent/caregiver
	Interview other adults living in the home
	 Obtain medical exam and/or treatment for the alleged victim (Note: In cases where exposure to methamphetamines is suspected, refer to Work Aid 4, as ALL children require medical evaluations)
	 Obtain drug screen result (of child that may have ingested or may have been administered drugs or chemical substances)
	Interview perpetrator or obtain interview from law enforcement
	◆ Interview witnesses, collaterals, other professionals or agencies
	Complete background checks
